Praise the Lord! We asked, and He provided! Thru an anonymous donor we have been able to buy our first plot for Emmaus Road Baptist Church! We had been meeting in our home, but quickly ran out of space as more and more people are *begging* to come to our services.

In the past weeks Jack, Dennis, Joseph, Josephat, and Kenneth have all gone out,



cleared the plot, dug the latrines, and put up a temporary structure until we can begin the work on the permanent church building, offices, and pastor's house that will be on this plot. Here, everything is cleared by hand in a process called "slashing". No weed eaters, no lawnmowers, just lots of arm work and sweat! Thankfully, no injuries, only a few bug bites, no snake bites, just sweat, sweat, sweat and plenty of joy at a task well done!



Now on to putting up that temporary structure, Zambian style.

on getting in the support poles, Jack and Kenneth put together the benches made from welded frames and boards.

One of our goals is to spread the Gospel not only here in Mazabuka, but in every surrounding village in this part of Zambia. While one missionary cannot possibly reach that many people, sending out teams on bicycles can certainly do the job. Again, a prayer has been answered! We asked for bicycles for our pastors, and the Lord has provided thru YOU! A very special TWALUMBA KAPATI (thank you very much) to Brother Meeks at Fellowship Baptist Church in Eden, N.C., to Light-house Indian Baptist Church in Houston, Tx., and to Bible Baptist Church in Pembroke Pines, Fl., for their wonderful gifts going to providing bicycles for our pastors!



Enough money was provided that we will be able to set aside part for more bicycles as we add more national pastors to our staff, and also enough to provide for additional spare parts as this rugged terrain is very rough on tires and tubes. These bicycles enable the pastors to not only get to the villages, but enable them to carry Bibles, training materials, and Sunday school material to newly planted churches.

We ask now that you keep these men in your prayers as they begin reaching out further into more compounds in and around Mazabuka, and as they move outward into the villages. Pray for protection from danger (human and animal), protection from injury, provision for food, for sustaining strength, for encouragement, and most of all—SOULS FOR THEIR LABOR!

Help! We need help! Want a fulfilling short term missions trip? Better yet, is God calling you to the mission field? We have a couple of friends that are being touched now by the Holy Spirit on what they should do, and we are constantly teasing them by adding to our messages and emails, “Zambia, Zambia, Zambia”, that it’s the voice of the Holy Spirit they hear and not us. But seriously, we do NEED help! We are now in four different ministry areas on Saturday for children’s outreach; Apollo Compound, Kabobola Compound, and Stage II Compound, with a return to Kabobola in the afternoon for soccer (futbol) with more teaching. We started with approximately 100 children in the three compounds, but now are reaching over 300 every Saturday. There is so much more that could be done but we are already spread so thin we don’t want to cheat the children by shortening the time needed for Bible story/teaching time. Even on days that it has been rainy and chilly (yes, it gets cool here in Zambia this time of year), the children have come and begged us to continue the time with them. So everyone huddles

under whatever shelter they can find and we sing and laugh and learn about “sweet, sweet, Jesus”. Thank the Lord that Dry Season is now here—no more rain!

Our hearts nearly burst as they all run to us crying “Mzungu! Mzungu! Makua! Makua!” as they wrap their little arms around us. It just doesn’t get any better than this.

What does the future hold for these babies, Heaven or Hell? So many of them have faced their own personal “hell on earth”. We weep over



them, pray over them, love them and give them the precious Word.

We started with learning the role of the woman in the Church but now are drawing closer to the precious one we call Friend, Alpha and Omega, Son of David, Priest and Prophet thru digging deeply into His Word and learning to pray. Only a couple of the ladies had Bibles when we started, and of course all wanted one. So we began a project of "earning" their Bibles. Each of the ladies pictured above, (and now 5 more) have earned their Bibles by memorizing Scripture. ALL of the other ladies are working on their verses too, and we are looking forward to placing a Bible in each hand so they may fall in love with the Savior who wrote them such precious love letters. Our very special thanks to BEAMS for these Bibles that are helping to bring the Light to the Dark Continent. May the Lord richly bless you and those who sacrifice by their giving for these precious ladies to have the Word of the Living God!

Our Prayer Needs

- Now that we have our plot, we are praying for funds for the permanent church building, the Pastor's house, a teaching/conference room with adjoining offices, and proper bathroom facilities. We will be using the conference room to have classes for the existing pastors, to start the Adult Literacy classes, and to start Sign Language classes. By building here we would be able to save over \$250/month on the office we now rent. We would also like to buy the plot next to the church in order to build a Bible college as well as dormitories within this year.
- We have about reached the end of our current vehicle and need one better suited to driving in the bush as we start reaching out into the surrounding villages. Please pray for a larger 4 wheel drive bush truck.
- We are starting an Adult Literacy class to meet two needs; literacy of course to aid those wanting to study God's Word when coming to the Bible College, and as an outreach tool to reach souls for Him. Pray for strength for both of us.
- Pray for growth, both in numbers and spiritually, for our new members of Emmaus Road Baptist Church.
- Pray that we will be well received by the two Chiefs we will be approaching as we make our plans to reach into the surrounding villages. We would like to move two of our pastors into village areas in order to begin new preaching points which then become churches. We need the blessing of the Chiefs in order to do this.
