Burning first, then crushing to give you that sweet, sweet sugar and molasses. While the press of the work here is sometimes painful, the rewards and results are so sweet. Our praises to the sweetest name we know—JESUS!

Rejoice with us as we give thanks during this Thanksgiving season for the many aspects of ministry the Lord has opened unto us.

EMMAUS ROAD BAPTIST CHURCH

The church continues to grow, even though members are having to ride in the back of an open truck in 110+ degree heat to come to services. We are currently in the process of taking down our temporary structure and beginning the digging of footers on Monday. It is a race to at least get a roof up before our rains begin. We are so excited to get this project underway! A **special thanks** to our home church of **Marion Baptist Church** in Marion, TX, for their gift of \$500, and to **Lighthouse Indian Baptist Church** in Houston, TX for their gift of \$250 toward the current church building project. **Lighthouse** also donated \$250 toward a new bush truck for which we are desperately in need. After the structure is underway for the church building itself, we will begin on our arbor for our young people so they also have a separate dry area in which to meet, then comes the conference/training building. If you would like to have a special part in this exciting project, please designate on your support check.

VILLAGE MINISTRY

Within the next two weeks we will be shifting Pastor Mate into a village approximately 25 miles from here to begin starting new preaching points which will then evolve into village churches. After December, Pastor Muyezi will join him in another village which is nearby in order for them to branch out into a wider area while being close enough to support each other in training projects. Pastor Muyezi has to wait until after December as he and his wife are awaiting the birth of their 3rd child. Please pray for these two families as they begin this new phase of ministry here.

PRISON MINISTRY

When God opens doors sometimes it's more than one at a time. Pastor Sialuta and Pastor Muyezi recently were given the opportunity to take our teens to a local prison for teen boys, preaching the Gospel and handing out tracts. During their first visit there were 20 professions of faith. There are approximately 60 to 70 boys in this facility. Jack and Pastor Muyezi will be going each Thursday afternoon. Please keep these boys in your prayers, but also our teens as they see the results of sin in lives. The opportunity has also been given for us to go into the local men's prison and to start a jail ministry at the local police department. We will definitely be in touch with Rock of Ages Prison Ministry for help in this area, but we could surely use some *help!* Want a sure blessing? Come to Zambia and help!

LADIE'S J.O.Y. FELLOWSHIP

Praising the Lord for the faithfulness of the ladies every Friday. They are growing spiritually and becoming more involved in the ministry. Praise the Lord for **4 more salvations** last week!!! Two of our ladies are going thru teachers training right now and helping with the children's ministry on Saturdays. One of the other ladies is excellent in organizing, and is currently helping with several projects we have going on. They have become real prayer warriors, and are such a blessing! Please keep them in your prayers, but especially two of our ladies who have become embroiled in family relations that have drawn them into drinking. Alcohol abuse is extremely high here, even among women. Approximately 75% of the women here drink to some degree, and this correlates with a 75% illegitimate birth rate. High I know, but the research is bearing out these numbers which absolutely burdens our hearts. It is sometimes so overwhelming, but we know the Lord is moving.

SERMON AUDIO

HOSPITAL MINISTRY

Several months ago we had asked many of you to pray for one of our pastors, Pastor Joseph Muyeyi. He was in the hospital with a pleural effusion from a chest infection. While there Joseph shared the Gospel with his fellow ward mates, leading two of the men to the Lord. Imagine, here he is sick and in pain, with a chest tube in place, but sharing the Gospel. Humbling isn't it? Thru this too the Lord has continued to work and the hospital has contacted us asking for a Sunday afternoon time of preaching and singing there. Two of our pastors will take over this opportunity as well as the ministry at the local jail as Pastor Muyeyi teaches our teens on Sunday afternoons.

TEEN MINISTRY

Every Sunday afternoon Pastor Muyeyi meets with our teen group of about 40 young people. Most of them have now earned their Bibles thru Scripture memorization and are now working on earning clothing thru learning the books of the Bible. Several of the young men are beginning to feel the call of the Holy Spirit into fulltime ministry, and are eagerly learning everything put in front of them. The recent trip to the boys prison has made a real impact on them, and you can see the quietness and soul searching as they think about the price these other boys are paying for their choices. We will be starting more training for them using Source of Light. How many Zambian pastors may be in this group? Move Holy Spirit, move!

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Our children's ministry is continuing strong, with over 300 children hearing the Gospel every Saturday. They are so excited, coming early every Saturday and wanting to come more often. Bless their hearts, we need 24 more hours a day and 7 more days a week, and **more workers!!** There have now been over 100 professions of faith with these little ones! Suffer the little children.....

SKYPE ANYONE?

We recently had a Skype conference with our home church, Marion Baptist Church during their yearly International Day of Praise in which they have a day of singing. We were able to get our choir together here at our home and broadcast live with our church in order to take a part in this special day. It was truly a miracle as we had internet the whole time! Our home church really enjoyed it, and our choir here was super excited to meet their spiritual Brothers and Sisters on TV and honor the Lord thru their singing. If this is something your church would like to do, we will do everything within our power to make it happen. Of course there is a bit of a time difference (we are ahead of the States 7 hours EST beginning this month), so we would have to work this out in order to do it live. Our folks are willing to stay up all night if they have to do so, but if you could do a Sunday morning during a conference or Sunday afternoon (or any other day in the afternoon your time) we would love to join you. Just let us know and we'll "git 'er done". It would be an honor.

PRAYER NEEDS

- \$4500 to complete our current church project, including **all** buildings on the plot.
- \$20,000 (approximately) to buy a bush vehicle as our current vehicle is old and challenged. We don't want new as this makes us a target, but vehicles are still expensive here for 4 wheel drive super suspension. We are also looking at buying a canter for transporting our members as it is currently costing us about \$125/month to rent a canter just for transport.
- Prayers for beginning our new ministry outreaches as well as beginning Zambia A.C.E. for our students, Source of Light training, training for our young men wanting to go into fulltime ministry, and training for new workers with the children's ministry.
- Prayers for Pastors Mate and Muyeyi as they move out into the villages to begin new works.
